ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come — Greeting

WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Healthcare Auxiliaries has 83 member auxiliaries representing more than 6,600 adults and 800 junior volunteers, all of whom enhance health care for British Columbians through volunteerism and community involvement, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Healthcare Auxiliaries has been working diligently since 1945 to strengthen its member auxiliaries through education, information and support, marking 2015 as the 70th anniversary of their organization, and

WHEREAS in 2014, member auxiliaries reported more than 1,330,000 volunteer hours and \$7,090,000 donated:

"Healthcare Auxiliary Day"

in the Province of British Columbia.
